

Worship Leader Ministry Overview:

Definition of worship: “expressing love and submission to God”

Personal:

1. Committed to being a fully devoted follower of Christ.
Demonstrating this commitment through:
 - a. regular study and understanding of God’s word, both in private and with the church.
 - b. a lifestyle of prayer and worship.
 - c. consistent involvement in personal discipleship, deepening your love for Christ.
2. Having and developing a servant’s heart toward others, in and outside the church.
3. Maintaining a positive attitude in spite of circumstances.
4. Demonstrate a willingness to follow the leadership of the Pastor and Elders of Hope Crossings, and encourage others to follow also.
5. Be a member of Hope Crossings.

Qualifications and Skills:

1. The ability to sing and lead others to “express submission and love to God”.
2. Demonstrate a cooperative attitude with all the ministries of Hope Crossings.
3. Recognize the musical and ministry gifts in others, and recruit them to become a part of the worship ministry team.
4. Effectively lead the worship ministry team as a small group (prayer, scripture devotion, etc.)

Responsibilities:

1. Communicate with Pastor Chris to decide with him the vision and emphasis of the worship ministry of the church and the songs that will be used in ministry.
2. Communicate the worship ministry vision to the members of the worship ministry team.
3. Select the worship songs - preferably one month in advance of the Sunday worship service.
4. Supply the worship ministry team music for all songs which will be used prior to rehearsals.
5. Schedule and lead the weekly rehearsals.
6. Appearance - establish and communicate the standard of dress and appearance for the worship team.
7. Communicate and cooperate with the sound techs during rehearsals and after the worship services, concerning the sound quality of the worship music and services.
8. Solve problems which arise with the worship ministry based on the vision of the worship ministry and Hope Crossings. Talk with Pastor Chris concerning any problems you’re not comfortable solving. Keep all personal conversations with the worship team confidential.
